#### Meet the staff

Staff are all looking forward to meeting families on Wednesday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, as an open house for all to step into the building and classrooms. Still too early to share anything definitive about progress at this early stage (10 days) but parent/ teacher interviews will be scheduled at a later date in November after progress reports are issued.

### **Spirit days**

We have gathered some ideas for spirit days this year, typically on the last Friday of the month, with the first one landing on Thursday, September 29th to ensure that the 30th is reserved for recognizing the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. We are asking that students wear their favourite colour all over, and as a standing backup, to wear Osgoode Owl swag wear otherwise. Families are always welcome to send along ideas for spirit days - we are open to your thoughts!

#### **Metcalfe Fair**

Metcalfe Fair is taking place on Friday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, which is also the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. The board has asked that no schools schedule field trips that that day. We have heard that other local schools have already scheduled field trips to the Fair. Gaynor is meeting with other local principals and staff to discuss. We also have a school bus driver shortage and are unsure if we could arrange for busses.

#### **Dental screening**

Ottawa Public Health will be running a dental screening for JK, SK and grade 2 students later in the year. This is a longstanding program that was put on hold during the pandemic so we are really pleased to have this back. May 17th is the date for Osgoode PS! This date has been added to the OPS website calendar.

### Sports and extracurricular clubs

Some sports have already started and others are coming. Currently Ms. Claridge and Mr. Meis are running soccer try-outs during recess. At the district level, there is recognition of the benefits of providing extracurriculars and clubs and so a central team has been established to re-imagine what this might look like. Access to reliable transportation for intra-school events such as soccer and cross-country is an ongoing concern, as is replacement staff when a staff member is accompanying students off property. ### **Terry Fox**

Several staff are busy getting ready for our Terry Fox event next Wednesday. The plan is to take students onto the path on that day so families should watch for the field trip permission form this week. This form covers all path field trips for the whole school year. Unless there is a significant amount of rain forecast, we will go ahead with the event - Terry went out every day, rain or shine!

## **Treasurer's Report - Maggie Matte**

- Ended the 2021-2022 school year with over \$15,900 in the bank.
- Over \$9,000 spendable. Some money has been allocated to future spending, including gym equipment, kinder toys, and Scientists in the Schools.
